

ABSENTEE VOTING

Absentee voting allows you to vote by mail if you are unable to vote at an Orem polling location. It is a two-step process that begins with you filling out an application form. This form can be [downloaded](#) or picked up at the Orem City Recorder's Office. When you've completed your form, mail or deliver it to the Orem City Recorder's Office at 56 N. State, Rm. 101, Orem, UT 84057. All applications must be received by Thursday, October 31st.

Once you have returned the form to the Recorder's Office you will be mailed a ballot, which can be used for absentee voting. All absentee ballots mailed back to the Recorder's Office must be postmarked by Monday, November 4th. If you miss this deadline, you can return your ballot in person to the Recorder's Office or a valid polling location during poll hours on Tuesday, November 5th.

Voter Information Guide

In the next two weeks, every Orem address will receive a printed Voter Information Pamphlet. This pamphlet will contain information on two ballot questions that will be posed to Orem residents, including arguments for and against each proposal. Please refer to these pamphlets for more information about the CARE Tax and Property Tax ballot questions.

This pamphlet does not contain information about individual candidates running for office. Candidate information was sent to

Orem residents prior to the Primary Election. Fitness Center Pool Improvements



Beginning this month, the Orem Fitness Center will begin construction on a new 1,500 square foot leisure pool and will make improvements to the existing pool area, including remodeling of the locker rooms. This project will be almost entirely funded through CARE tax revenues that the city has allocated to recreation for the past 7 years.

Construction of the new pool will not impact the daily operations of the existing swimming pool. However, the Fitness Center will be closed for two weeks beginning on February 17th, 2014, as staff and construction crews complete renovations to the locker rooms and clean the facility.


Upon reopening, the pool area will remain closed for an additional 4–6 weeks while the Fitness Center makes added improvements, including a repainted ceiling and walls, installation of new high efficiency LED lighting, replacement of the pool deck, replacement of windows and doors, and repairs to the HVAC system to help with air quality and humidity.

Amenities of the new pool will include the following:

- Elevated water slide with a 16' tower
- 100' Current Channel
- Play structure with dump bucket
- Myrtha Mound
- Zero-depth entry
- Programming space for swim lessons and water aerobics

We are excited to provide this new amenity to Orem residents and

look forward to seeing the improvements take shape!
