

Orem Neighborhood Plans Goals

Neighborhood Preservation

- Maintain code and law enforcement to preserve a visually appealing and safe neighborhood environment.
- Continue to enforce city restrictions on illegal accessory apartments and over-occupied homes.
- Consider "Feed a Cop" program at the schools to promote positive relationship with law enforcement.
- Encourage more frequent neighborhood cleanup service projects.
- Address neighborhood concerns of illegal dumping at the local parks.
- Protect historic sites within the Neighborhoods.
- Improve code and law enforcement to maintain a visually appealing and safe neighborhood environment.
- Maintain code and law enforcement to preserve the quality and safety of the neighborhoods.
- Enforce City restrictions on illegal accessory apartments and over-occupied homes.
- Enforce City restrictions on abandoned vehicles, junk filled yards, and two dog maximum.
- Consider a rental license program to better manage absentee landlords in single family residential neighborhoods.
- Improve ability of residents to submit a concern and receive feedback from police officers.
- Increase the number of police officers and /or NPU staff to provide a greater police presence in the community (neighborhood policing).
- Enforce City restrictions on abandoned vehicles, junk filled yards and illegal / over-occupied rentals.
- Encourage volunteer/service days for neighborhood beautification for those neighbors who are struggling.
- Educate residents on the Orem Help Center's resources on code enforcement to facilitate effective neighborhood policing and code enforcement.
- Plan and schedule more frequent volunteer neighborhood cleanup days for neighborhood beautification.
- Enforce the use of school property for education purposes only, especially in regard to alcohol and tobacco use on school property, the use of property during night-time hours, and advertising signage.
- Support the City's efforts in working to increase the number of police officers and NPU staff when practical to ensure a safe, clean, and family friendly neighborhood.
- Consider a rental license program or landlord occupancy requirement to better limit absentee landlords in single family residential areas.
- Educate residents on the Orem Help Center's resources on code enforcement to facilitate effective neighborhood policing and code enforcement.
- Plan and schedule more frequent volunteer neighborhood cleanup days for neighborhood beautification.
- Enforce requirements for off-street parking for accessory apartments, short-term rentals, and in-home businesses to reduce street congestion.
- Support measures for allocating more resources for NPU/Police and suggest simplifying police/fire career ladder system

Neighborhood Preservation

- Support parking enforcement division formation, and option for non-police code enforcement, including a neighborhood parking permit plan
- Focus on better education for snow-removal on sidewalks
- Consider campaign in neighborhood to address noise ordinance.
- Consider revisions to the accessory apartment ordinance, ways to remove burden on creation, methods to address absentee landlords through owner occupied definition of accessory apartment
- Identify methods to build better neighborhood unity
- Support Property All-Star program from City
- Address off-leash dogs in neighborhood
- Consider developing neighborhood app for reporting problems
- Explore options to encourage better property maintenance.
- Provide information to help educate citizens on Neighborhood Preservation Unit resources, explain differences between 311 and Dispatch, and encourage residents to join Citizen Academy.
- Encourage a strong community network through knowing all your neighbors, regardless of religious affiliations, and understanding their needs.
- Encourage citizens to help each other first, then call police for larger issues.
- Explore options for mitigating transient problem along University Parkway and Sandhill Road.
- Increase neighborhood awareness through encouraging more involvement in community events such as the Police picnics.
- Educate residents regarding anonymous reporting to address problem properties.
- Support City Council's efforts in addressing overburdened NPU officers.
